Our Need

Mark 6:30-32 ^{NIV}

The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught. ³¹ Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, **“Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.”** ³² So they went away by themselves in a boat to a solitary place.



Our Need

Mark 6:33-34a ^{NIV}

But many who saw them leaving recognized them and ran on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. ³⁴ When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd...

Our Need
Who Jesus is

Mark 6:34 ^{NIV}

When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, **he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd.** So he began teaching them many things.



Our Need

Mark 6:35-37 ^{NIV}

By this time it was late in the day, so his disciples came to him. “This is a remote place,” they said, “and it’s already very late.
³⁶ Send the people away so that they can go to the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat.”
³⁷ But he answered, **“You give them something to eat.”** They said to him, “That would take more than half a year’s wages! Are we to go and spend that much on bread and give it to them to eat?”



Our Need

Mark 6:38 NIV

“How many loaves do you have?” he asked. “Go and see.” When they found out, they said, “Five—and two fish.”



Our Need

Mark 6:39-40 ^{NIV}

Then Jesus **directed (commanded) them to have all the people sit down (recline) in groups on the green grass.** ⁴⁰ So they sat down in groups of hundreds and fifties.



Our Need
What Jesus does

Mark 6:41 ^{NIV}

Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then **he gave them to his disciples to distribute to the people.** He also divided the two fish among them all.



Our Need
What Jesus does

Mark 6:42-44 ^{NIV}

They all ate and were satisfied, ⁴³ and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces of bread and fish. ⁴⁴ The number of the men who had eaten was five thousand.



Psalm 23 ^{NIV}

¹ The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing.

² He makes me lie down in green pastures,
